What made a high-energy 12-year-old slow down and connect with the world? Photography, the darkroom in particular, for one recent student named Jack.

Just like many of the kids who were students at In-Sight before him, Jack was excited and eager to learn digital photography but his attention often wandered to the distractions of a screen. However, something changed for Jack when he attended an Open Lab Night and got to bring his digital artwork into the darkroom, a place where the only light sources allowed are the red safe-lights.

At first Jack seemed uneasy in the minimal red light, but after a few minutes of observing the process Jack's teacher saw him relax as he took it all in. He was fascinated with each step of the developing process and ready to try it himself. When the image finally appeared in the developer bath, Jack turned to his teacher and said, "This is incredible! I didn't know it could be like this!"

Jack's experience in the darkroom is just one example of the many magical moments that happen when youth have the space to create and share their artwork. In-Sight has a special value in today's sometimes chaotic world. Through photography, In-Sight nurtures connections to the world and the self supporting healthy adolescent development.

We are so grateful for all of our dedicated supporters who helped ensure youth have access to our programming and helped us grow over the last 30 years. In 2022, to celebrate the anniversary of John Willis and Bill Ledger's first In-Sight class and to affirm a commitment to accessibility to the photographic arts, In-Sight supporters raised \$30,000 for a Founders' Fund! And most importantly, thank you to everyone who recommended our classes to youth they know!

# WHAT OUR STUDENTS HAVE TO SAY

75% of students feel they are likely to use skills they learned at In-Sight in life outside of class

89% of students say they want to take another class in the future

7 students received digital and analog cameras and equipment through our equipment donation program






